

We are inquiring about the financial conflict of interest and industry-academia-government collaboration activities between faculty members and staff themselves and for-profit organizations, non-profit corporations such as incorporated associations, incorporated foundations, NPOs, medical corporations, and organizations, without corporate status (hereinafter referred to as “companies and organizations” )

\*Central Government Ministries and agencies in Japan (including independent administrative agencies, national research and development agencies, and testing laboratories and research institutes designated by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology), local governments, and overseas public research institutes (such as National Research Institutes, etc.) are not subject to reporting. Grants-in-Aid for Scientific Research are not subject to reporting.

①	Ownership of unlisted shares: one share or more (including shares of corporations that have gone public within the past one year), Capital injection for LLC, LLP, private limited company etc.
②	Ownership of listed shares (5% or more of outstanding shares)
③	Ownership of share warrant (unexercised)
④	Receipt of financing/guarantees (other than from banks or other financial institutions)
⑤	Receipt of annual income of more than one million yen, the total income received from one corporate entity or organization. *This includes remuneration for a second job, honoraria, dividends from shares and the sales of shares, etc. However, it does not include income from lectures at schools (part-time lecturers) or income from medical procedures from medical institutions, etc.

⑱	<p>Procurement of goods, equipment, systems, etc. and business outsourcing of annual amounts exceeding one million yen per year (In addition to the matters for educational and research purposes; this includes cases where a decision-maker is introducing university facilities, etc. including the determination of specifications and selection of models. Device repair and services are also included.)</p> <p>*This is the total amount received from a single corporation (one company) or a single organization (such as a research group or group without corporate status). Accumulated small amounts are included in the annual amounts of one million yen.</p> <p>*The term “decision-maker” refers to a person in a position that carries the right to make decisions or being a member (or the chairperson) of an internal committee established for the purpose of making decisions.</p>
