(February 6, 2020)

From February 1, 2020, the novel coronavirus has been labeled as a designated infectious disease, and **students, faculty and staff diagnosed with the infectious disease will be suspended from attending classes and/or work until they are cured.**

Please follow the instructions below in order to thoroughly carry out infectious disease control within the university. **These instructions may change in the future as the situation changes.**

- ① Students, faculty and staff members who have returned or newly arrived from China to Japan after January 15, 2020 => At the time of entry to Japan (including those who had a transit in China)
- ② Persons who have come into close contact with above person => At the time of contact

- Keep a close eye on your health while recording body temperature on the Self-Health Checklist for 2 weeks after entering Japan or having close contact
- Refrain from going out and stay at home

Have a fever/coughing within 2 weeks after entering Japan or having close contact

No symptoms appear for 2 weeks
